Tata Steel is looking for young and bright diploma/degree holders in Mechanical / Electrical/ Electronics to join as Junior Engineer Trainees. Selected candidates will undergo 12 months training in the company's Technical Training Institute before placement in the plant.

On successful completion of training, candidates will be placed with position of **Junior Engineer-1** which is a critical position with challenging assignments in operation and maintenance of plant and equipment. The job also requires leadership capability and participation in improvement initiatives to consistently achieve excellent operational results.

Minimum Educational Qualification: 3/4 Years full time Diploma/Degree in Engineering (Mechanical / Electrical/ Electronics) recognized by AICTE.

Only the candidates who will be completing their diploma/degree in 2019 are eligible to appear in the selection process.

The selected candidates must submit certificate of completion of degree/diploma by 30th August 2019. Training of those selected candidates who fail in their Degree/Diploma programme or are unable to produce the pass certificate by 30th August 2019, will be terminated.

Marks: Minimum 60% (aggregate) of all semesters.

Age: For General Candidates: Should have been born between March 1, 1994 and July 31, 2002 (both days inclusive)
For SC/ST Candidates: Should have been born between March 1, 1993 and July 31, 2002 (both days inclusive)

Domicile: State of Odisha

Streams: Mechanical, Electrical and Electronics

Minimum Physical standards: Height: 152 cm. (for girls 142 cm)	Weight: 45 Kg. (for girls 40 Kg.)
Expansion of Chest: 5 cm	Eyesight: 6/6 in both eyes with glass
Power of Glasses \pm 4.0 maximum	Colour Vision: Normal

Duration of Training: 12 (Twelve) months starting from **August 2019**.

Stipend: The candidates undergoing training will be paid a stipend of ₹ 11,419/- (Rupees Eight thousand only) per month during their training period.

Placement: On successful completion of training, the selected candidates will be considered for placement in **Kalinganagar** or **any location** of the company.

Registration with BOPT: Selected candidates will be registered with the Board of Practical Training (Eastern Region) for one year under the Apprentice (Amendment) Act, 1973 subject to their eligibility.

Selection Procedure: **Online Written Test** will be conducted in **multiple batches** from **4th February to 10th February 2019**, followed by personal interview of short listed candidates at Jamshedpur/Kalinganagar. Assessment dates will be communicated to the college Training and Placement coordinator. Admit cards will be mailed to the candidates in their individual mail IDs.

Successful candidates in interview will be medically examined at Kalinganagar/Bhubaneswar/Jamshedpur to meet the minimum physical standards. Those who are found medically fit will be offered admission to the programme, which is scheduled to commence from 1st August 2019.
